PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT AND WAIVER

Rules of Participation:

1. Participants must not interrupt the speaker.
2. When the speaker allows questions:
 - a. the participant must frame his/her question in general terms.
 - b. There shall be no request for legal advice on their own case.
 - c. The participant's question should be short and to the point.
3. Participants shall refrain from naming their spouses, children or other persons when speaking in the group.
4. Participants shall refrain from swearing or derogatory comments.
5. Participants shall allow others to speak; so that all participants have equal time to ask their questions.
