## PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT AND WAIVER

## **Rules of Participation:**

- 1. Participants must not interrupt the speaker.
- 2. When the speaker allows questions:
  - a. the participant must frame his/her question in general terms.
  - b. There shall be no request for legal advice on their own case.
  - c. The participant's question should be short and to the point.
- 3. Participants shall refrain from naming their spouses, children or other persons when speaking in the group.
- 4. Participants shall refrain from swearing or derogatory comments.
- 5. Participants shall allow others to speak; so that all participants have equal time to ask their questions.
